



Kingston Horticultural Society Community Improvement Fund Guidelines 2010

A limited amount of money is available to assist groups or individuals within the boundaries of Greater Kingston to complete projects of a horticultural nature which will benefit the citizens of Kingston. Hardscape materials [for example, gravel for paths, wood for planter boxes and the like] and durable items such as garden tools are acceptable expenses. Plant material may be approved at the discretion of the Committee.

A group or individual may apply for a sum between \$100.00 and \$250.00. Successful applicants from one year may reapply in the next but preference may be given to first-time applicants.

Applications must be received by the Community Improvement Fund Committee of Kingston Horticultural Society by Thursday, April 15, 2010. All applicants will be notified of the Committee decisions and cheques will be issued by May 24, 2010. The decisions of the Committee are final and no protests will be allowed.

Kingston Horticultural Society will require a written report on the finished project by October 1, 2010 and photographs are desirable. The Committee may visit the site to view the results of the work.
