



## Kingston Horticultural Society Community Improvement Fund Guidelines 2012

A limited amount of money is available to assist groups or individuals within the boundaries of Greater Kingston to complete projects of a horticultural nature which will benefit the citizens of Kingston. Hardscape materials and durable items are preferred expenses for this grant. Examples of items we have funded include gravel for paths, mulch, soil or compost, wood for planter boxes, garden tools, hoses, shed, rain barrels, composters, bird feeders, picnic tables or benches. Perennial plant material, including trees and shrubs may be approved at the discretion of the Committee.

A group or individual may apply for a sum between \$100.00 and \$250.00. Successful applicants from one year may reapply in the next but preference may be given to first-time applicants.

Applications must be received by the Community Improvement Fund Committee of Kingston Horticultural Society by Monday, April 16, 2012. All applicants will be notified of the Committee decisions and cheques will be issued by May 24, 2012. The decisions of the Committee are final.

Kingston Horticultural Society will provide a plaque or sign to be displayed at the project site. We require a written report (with photographs if possible) on the finished project by October 1, 2012. The Committee may visit the site to view the results of the work.
